ABOUT THIS WINERY

Francis Ford Coppola was first exposed to winemaking while growing up in New York; his grandfather and uncles were making wine in their basement using grapes they shipped in from California. After marrying in 1962, Francis and his wife Eleanor became the owners of a substantial and beautiful wine estate outside of San Francisco. They have now been married for over 50 years and still live on the estate with their family.

TASTING NOTES

This vintage exhibits aromas of boysenberries, cherries, leather, and nutmeg. It is dark magenta in appearance with tasting notes of plums, raspberries, cocoa, and toasted oak.

VITICULTURAL NOTES

The 2012 Diamond Syrah experienced an excellent California climate with steady, mild temperatures that persisted throughout the summer. This ideal weather helped achieve a rich, deeply concentrated fruit that is layered with alluring spice notes, a gracious structure, and supple tannins.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Christophe Lussier provided this Syrah with high levels of concentration and intense blackberry aromas from extended ripening on the vineyard's eastern slope. The Paso Robles vineyard delivered raspberry flavors and a rich, velvety texture. The combination of these two fruits blended with a small amount of Petite Sirah from Hames Valley produced a wine with depth, structure and fine aromatics.
